

Admission of Undergraduates to 5000-Level Courses for Undergraduate Credit [C1]

Under special circumstances, undergraduate students in good standing at UMSL may enroll in 5000-level courses for undergraduate credit. Approvals from the advisor, department chairperson, academic dean, and dean of the Graduate School are required. In rare cases, students subsequently admitted to the Graduate School may petition for graduate credit for 5000-level courses that they took as undergraduates, as long as those courses were not applied to their undergraduate degrees. This form should be submitted via e-mail to GradSchoolForms@umsl.edu – paper forms will not be accepted.

- Undergraduate student enrolling in a graduate level course for undergraduate credit for bachelor’s degree
- 2+3 student enrolling in a graduate-level course to be used for graduate/undergraduate credit.
