Degree Program:

- A minimum of 18 credit hours of graduate-level courses with a minimum 3.0 GPA in the program.
- This online certificate is offered collaboratively with the UM-Kansas City School of Education and the UM-St. Louis College of Education. The program is designed to fill a niche in educational leadership preparation identified by AACCC and allow candidates to develop skills and knowledge relevant to a community college setting.

Entrance Requirements:

1. Application
 - a. <http://www.umsl.edu/gradschool/prospective/apply-now.html>
2. Three Letters of Recommendation
3. Transcript (s) and Entrance examination(s)
 - a. An official BA or Master's transcript must be submitted.
 - b. International applicants are required to document English proficiency by providing scores from an internationally accepted standardized examination before a decision is made on admission.
4. Grade Point Average
 - a. Minimum of 3.0 on 4.0 scale.
