1. Graduate School Application

2. Official transcripts from all universities attended
3. Entrance examinations
  - a. International applicants are required to document English proficiency by providing scores from an internationally accepted standardized examination before a decision is made on admission.
4. Grade Point Average
  - a. Minimum of 2.75 on 4.0 scale in undergraduate categories and 3.00 in graduate work.
