- A minimum of 18 credit hours numbered 4000 or above (half must be at the 5000 level or above), with at least one course in each of the following topic areas:

 - Psychological Aspects of Aging
 - Health and Physical Aspects of Aging
 - Socio-cultural Aspects of Aging
- Practicum in gerontology is also required.

1. Application

2. Three Letters of Recommendation
3. Transcripts and Entrance examination(s)
 - a. An official BA or Master's transcript must be submitted.
 - b. International applicants are required to document English proficiency by providing scores from an internationally accepted standardized examination before a decision is made on admission.
4. Grade Point Average
 - a. Minimum of 2.75 on 4.0 scale
