- A minimum of 18 credit hours numbered 6000 or above
- 12 hours of the above hours being core courses, 3 hours chosen from a list of elective courses, and 3 hours of internship (or a professional field experience equivalent to the internship).

### Application Requirements

1. Graduate School Application
  - a. <http://umsl.edu/go/Apply-Now>
2. Letters of Recommendation
  - a. Two letters of recommendation are required. At least one letter must be from a college level instructor.
3. Transcripts and Entrance examination(s)
  - a. Official BA or Master's degree transcript.
  - b. International applicants are required to document English proficiency by providing scores from an internationally accepted standardized examination before a decision is made on admission.
4. Grade Point Average
  - a. Minimum of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale
