1. Graduate School Application

2. Letters of Recommendation (Contact department)
3. Transcripts and Entrance examination(s)
  - a. Official transcripts from all universities attended are required.
  - b. No entrance examinations are required.
  - c. International applicants are required to document English proficiency by providing scores from an internationally accepted standardized examination before a decision is made on admission.
4. Grade Point Average
  - a. Minimum of 2.75 on 4.0 scale
