### Application Requirements

1. Graduate School Application - <http://umsl.edu/go/Apply-Now>
2. Transcripts and/or Entrance examinations
  - a. Official transcripts from all universities attended are required
  - b. International applicants are required to document English proficiency by providing scores from an internationally accepted standardized examination before a decision is made on admission.
3. Grade Point Average
  - a. Minimum of 2.75 on 4.0 scale in undergraduate categories and 3.00 in graduate work.
