Application Requirements

1. Application - <http://umsl.edu/go/Apply-Now>
2. Letters of recommendation (contact department)
3. Transcripts and/or Entrance examinations
 - a. Official transcripts from all universities attended are required. International applicants are required to document English proficiency by providing scores from an internationally accepted standardized examination before a decision is made on admission.
4. Grade Point Average
 - a. Minimum of 2.75 on 4.0 scale.
